AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS MAY ATTEND CERTAIN MEETINGS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS POLICE ASSOCIATION WITHOUT LOSS OF COMPENSATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 100G½ of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as provided in
- 2 chapter 477 of the acts of 1979, is hereby amended by striking out
- 3 the last sentence of the said section.
