AN ACT RELATIVE TO CONTRACTS OF INSURANCE AGAINST LOSSES BY FIRE.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is, in part, to provide immediate relief for
3 applicants for fire insurance from the invasion of privacy, therefore
4 it is declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate
5 preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section ninety-eight of chapter one hundred and seventy-five of
2 the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter three
3 hundred and eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and eighty-one,
4 is hereby repealed.
