### AN ACT DIRECTING THE COMMONWEALTH TO REIMBURSE CITIES AND TOWNS FOR THE COSTS OF TRAFFIC SIGNALIZATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the com-  
2 monwealth shall reimburse fifty percent of the costs of traffic  
3 signalization to any city or town which provides to the secretary of  
4 transportation sufficient evidence required by said secretary that  
5 such traffic signalization has been installed by said city or town and  
6 expenditures have been certified by the auditors or town account-  
7 tants of each respective city or town after application therefor.
