AN ACT RELATIVE TO BENEFITS PAYABLE UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 An individual receiving benefits under the employment security
- 2 law, who, after four weeks of receiving such benefits, refuses to
- 3 accept a position at a salary equal to seventy-five per cent of his
- 4 former salary shall not be eligible to receive any further benefits.
