By Mr. Angelo of Saugus, petition of Steven Angelo that Robert B. McCarthy, an employee of the Registry of Motor Vehicles, be eligible for membership in the contributory retirement system for state employees. Public Service.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ELIGIBILITY OF ROBERT B. MCCARTHY FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEMS FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of general or special law to the
2 contrary, Robert B. McCarthy, a permanent employee of the
3 registry of motor vehicles shall be given full credit for retirement
4 purposes for all his prior services with the commonwealth, includ-
5 ing service with said registry of motor vehicles, and any and all
6 service related in any way thereto, by filing with the state retire-
7 ment board an application on the prescribed forms for member-
8 ship in the state employees retirement systems; but he shall not be
9 entitled to such credit for such prior service unless, within six
10 months from the effective date of this act, he shall have paid into
11 the annuity savings funds of the state retirement system, in one
12 sum, an amount equal to the contribution he would have been
13 required to pay had he applied for membership and been accepted
14 in said retirement system when he would have been first eligible.
