AN ACT RELATING TO THE COSTS OF CONVERSION OF ELECTRICITY FROM DIRECT CURRENT TO ALTERNATING CURRENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary, whenever the conversion of the electricity used by any
3 customer of the Boston Edison Company from direct current to
4 alternating current is required as a condition to the continued
5 supply of electricity to such customer by the Boston Edison Com-
6 pany, whether or not such condition is imposed as a result of an
7 order of the Department of Public Utilities or other governmental
8 department or agency, the Boston Edison Company shall pay all
9 expenses incurred as a result of such conversion and shall not
10 impose any charges for such expenses upon any customer using
11 direct current or upon any customer using alternating current.
