AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FEES CHARGED NON-RESIDENTS AT STATE CAMPING AREAS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (2) of section 2D of Chapter 132A of the General
2 Laws, as inserted by section one of chapter 656 of the acts of 1958,
3 is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following
4 two sentences: — Fees charged to persons who are not residents of
5 the commonwealth, for the use of state camping areas, shall be at
6 least one dollar per night for the first year and at least two dollars
7 each year thereafter greater than the fee charged to residents.
8 Monies received on account of these additional fees shall be ex-
9 pended by the State Recreation Areas Fund to hire additional
10 security guards.
