By Mr. McGlynn of Medford, petition of Michael J. McGlynn that the Massachusetts Port Authority be directed to monitor noise levels of aircraft over the cities of Malden and Medford. Transportation.

AN ACT MONITORING THE NOISE LEVEL OF AIRCRAFT OVER THE CITIES OF MALDEN AND MEDFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Massachusetts Port Authority is hereby authorized and
2 directed to construct and maintain four noise monitors in the city
3 of Malden and four noise monitors in the city of Medford. Such
4 monitors shall be electronically connected to Massport Noise
5 Abatement Office at Logan Airport in the city of Boston or shall
6 measure the noise level of aircraft flying over the cities of Malden
7 and Medford. Any commercial airline that allows its aircraft to
8 exceed seventy-five dBA over said cities shall be liable to a fine not
9 to exceed one thousand dollars and such fine shall be paid over to
10 the city in which said violation occurred.
