AN ACT RELATIVE TO CONSUMER CREDIT REPORT AGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 53G of chapter 93 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 section 1 of chapter 805 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by
3 striking out subsection (b) and inserting in place thereof the follow-
4 ing subsection: —

5 (b) Any person who procures or causes to be prepared any
6 correspondence on any consumer, shall send to such consumer a
7 copy of such correspondence within a reasonable period of time,
8 and make a complete disclosure of the nature and the scope of the
9 correspondence or the investigation requested. The copy and dis-
10 closure shall be made in a writing mailed not later than five days
11 from the date on which the original correspondence was sent to the
12 party requesting it.
