AN ACT PROVIDED FOR INCREASED RELOCATION TIME FOR ELDERLY AND HANDICAPPED TENANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of chapter 239 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 235 of the acts of 1972, is hereby
3 amended by adding after the words "for periods not exceeding six
4 months in the aggregate," and before the words "as the court may
5 deem just and reasonable" the following additional words: — "or,
6 for a period not exceeding twelve months or for periods not
7 exceeding twelve months in the aggregate in the case of premises
8 occupied by a handicapped individual or an individual sixty years
9 of age or older,".

1 SECTION 2. Section 9 of chapter 239 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 235 of the acts of 1972, is hereby
3 further amended by adding at the end of the first full paragraph the
4 following additional paragraph: —
5 "Handicapped Individual" means any individual who has a
6 physical or mental impairment which substantially limits one or
7 more of such person's major life activities; who has a record of
8 such an impairment; or is regarded as having such an impairment.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO

ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO

SECTION 1. The Charter of the University of Chicago is amended to read as follows: "The University of Chicago shall be a corporation of the State of Illinois, organized for the purpose of promoting the advancement of the sciences, the liberal arts, and the professions, and for the education of the youth of the State and of the world."

SECTION 2. The Board of Trustees of the University of Chicago is authorized to make such amendments to the Charter as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its passage by the Board of Trustees of the University of Chicago.
