AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR AN ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT CLERK IN THE
SPRINGFIELD DIVISION OF THE JUVENILE COURT DEPARTMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 58 of Chapter 218 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 213 of chapter 478 of the acts of 1978, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the third paragraph and inserting
4 in place thereof the following paragraph: —

5 Each division shall have a clerk, who shall be appointed by the
6 governor, with the advice and consent of the council and shall hold
7 office during good behavior, subject, however, to retirement under
8 the provisions of any applicable general or special law relative to
9 retirement systems. The Boston division of the juvenile court de-
10 partment shall have a first assistant clerk and five assistant clerks,
11 who shall be appointed by the clerk subject to the approval of the
12 first justice. The Springfield division of the juvenile court depart-
13 ment shall have a first assistant clerk and one assistant clerk, who
14 shall be appointed by the clerk subject to the approval of the first
15 justice.
