AN ACT PLACING THE TOWN OF PRINCETON IN THE JUDICIAL JURISDICTION OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF LEOMINSTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 550 of the acts of
3 1980, is hereby further amended by striking out the first paragraph
4 under the caption "Worcester" and inserting in place thereof the
5 following paragraph: —

6 The central district court of Worcester, held at Worcester; Wor-
7 cester, Auburn, Millbury, Paxton, West Boylston, Holden, Rut-
8 land, Barre and Oakham; excepting cases of juvenile offenders
9 under seventeen and cases of neglect, wayward or delinquent
10 children.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 218, as so amended,
2 is hereby further amended by striking out the tenth paragraph
3 under the caption "Worcester" and inserting in place thereof the
4 following paragraph: —

5 The district court of Leominster, held at Leominster; Leomins-
6 ter and Princeton.
