Ordered, That the joint rules of the senate and house of representatives be amended by inserting after rule 10A the following rule: —

10B. All business which is pending before the General Court at the end of the annual and any special sessions, occurring in the odd numbered year, shall be resumed at the commencement of the second session of the same General Court, in the even numbered year, in the same manner as if prorogation or dissolution of the General Court had not taken place.
