### AN ACT INCREASING THE PENALTIES ON VIOLATIONS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES INVOLVING MINOR CHILDREN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by insert-  
2 ing a new section: —

3 *Section 56A.* Upon conviction of any owner or his agent of  
4 liquor premises, under section fifty-six of this chapter and related  
5 chapters of the General Laws, who illegally sells to a minor any  
6 alcoholic beverage, shall cause the premises to be closed for thirty  
7 days. There shall be no appeal to local licensing authorities or to  
8 the commission under section sixty-seven of this chapter.
