AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW RELATIVE TO CONDUCT IN PUBLIC CONVEYANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out Section 43 and inserting in place thereof the following new
3 Section: —

4 *Section 43.* Whoever, in or upon a railroad carriage, steamboat
5 or other public conveyance or in a terminal or other facilities of the
6 Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority, is disorderly, or
7 disturbs or annoys travelers in or upon the same by making noise
8 with a radio or in any other manner, by profane, obscene or
9 indecent language, or by indecent behavior, shall be punished as
10 provided in Section forty.
