AN ACT PROVIDING FOR FINE AND/OR INCARCERATION FOR COERCION
ON ABSENTEE BALLOTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary,
2 whosoever shall interfere, coerce or attempt to coerce a person into
3 voting by the Absentee Ballot method, or coercing their vote on
4 said Absentee Ballot, or changing in any way said vote or Absentee
5 Ballot shall be subject to a fine of \$5,000.00 and/or a year in the
6 House of Correction.
