AN ACT TO REDUCE THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THE RIGHT ON RED LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 8 of Chapter 89 of the General Laws, as amended, is  
2 hereby further amended by striking out the last three words of the  
3 second paragraph and substituting therefor the following two  
4 words: — twenty dollars.
