AN ACT PROVIDING FOR TEN ADDITIONAL JUSTICES IN THE SUPERIOR COURT DEPARTMENT OF THE TRIAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 211B of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by Section 1 of Chapter 575 of the Acts of
3 1980, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 7, the word
4 "sixty-three" and inserting in place thereof the word: — seventy-
5 three.

1 SECTION 2. Section 2 of said chapter 211B, as most recently
2 amended by section 2 of said chapter 575, is hereby further amend-
3 ed by striking out, in line 1, the word "fifty-six", and inserting in
4 place thereof the word: — sixty-six.

1 SECTION 3. Section 1 of chapter 212 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 116 of chapter 478 of the Acts of
3 1978, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 3, the word
4 "fifty-six" and inserting in place thereof the word: — sixty-six.
