**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS TO BORROW MONEY FOR CONSTRUCTING AND EQUIPPING AN ADDITION TO THE PRESENT FACILITIES OF THE FIRST DISTRICT COURT OF SOUTHERN MIDDLESEX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts is hereby  
2 authorized to construct and equip an addition for the first district  
3 court of Southern Middlesex, including any necessary landscap-  
4 ing, parking and furnishings, such sums as may be necessary, not  
5 exceeding, in the aggregate, one million seven hundred and fifty  
6 thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes authorized by section one of this  
2 act, the state treasurer upon request of the Governor, may borrow  
3 upon the credit of the state such sums as may be necessary, not  
4 exceeding, in the aggregate, one million seven hundred and fifty  
5 thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the common-  
6 wealth therefor, which shall bear on their face the words First  
7 District Court of Southern Middlesex Court House Addition Con-  
8 struction Loan, Act of 1982. Each authorized issue shall constitute  
9 a separate loan and such loans shall be payable in not more than  
10 twenty years from their dates. The commonwealth may sell said  
11 securities at public or private sale, upon such terms and conditions

12 as the State Treasurer may deem proper, but not for less than their  
 13 par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except as herein  
 14 provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
