AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A MESSENGER IN THE PROBATE COURT OF BARNSTABLE COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 217 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
- 2 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 32D.* The judge of probate for Barnstable County may
- 4 appoint a messenger for the court of probate and insolvency for
- 5 said court, may remove them at his pleasure and may fill vacancy
- 6 caused by removal or otherwise. Said messenger shall wait upon
- 7 said court, and perform such duties as the judge may direct,
- 8 including duty as a court officer of said court. Said messenger shall,
- 9 while in attendance on said court, wear uniform such as the court
- 10 shall order, to be furnished at the expense of said county.
