AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RULES OF EVIDENCE AND PROCEDURE IN CERTAIN ADJUDICATORY PROCEEDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 10 of chapter 30A of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 1 of chapter 60 of the acts of 1978, is hereby
- 3 further amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 The procedure in any adjudicatory proceeding in which an
- 5 agency may at the conclusion thereof impose a fine of one thou-
- 6 sand dollars or more upon any person shall be in accordance with
- 7 the Massachusetts rules of civil procedure and the rules of evidence
- 8 applicable in courts of law.
