AN ACT ESTABLISHING TUITION CHARGES FOR NON-RESIDENT ALIENS AT INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 15A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 5 the following section: —

3 *Section 5A.* The board of regents shall fix and establish as the
4 charges for tuition and room and board at all institutions of public
5 higher education to aliens who are non-residents of the common-
6 wealth the amount of money equal to average amount necessary to
7 maintain a student at such an institution.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section 1 of this act shall not
2 apply to any non-resident alien who became a student at an institu-
3 tion of public higher education in the commonwealth prior to its
4 effective date.
