By Mr. Walsh, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 144) of Charles B. Gray, Jr., and Joseph B. Walsh for legislation to prohibit the termination of employment of certain injured workers. Commerce and Labor.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE TERMINATION OF THE EMPLOYMENT OF CERTAIN INJURED WORKERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 51B of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as amend-
2 ed by chapter 336 of the acts of 1969, is hereby further
3 amended by inserting, after the first sentence, the following
4 sentence: — The employment of an injured worker whose in-
5 jury is subject to the provisions of chapter one hundred and
6 fifty-two shall not be terminated while said worker is inca-
7 pacitated for work.
