**AN ACT REQUIRING THE DIVISION OF INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENTS TO
GIVE NOTICE OF HEARING TO THE INJURED EMPLOYEE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 152 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting, after section 12A, the following section: —
- 3 *Section 12B.* Any notice of a hearing required under this
- 4 chapter or any rule or regulation of the division to be given
- 5 to the attorney for a claimant shall also be given to the
- 6 claimant.
