AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF A DEPUTY ASSISTANT REGISTER AND CLERK TO THE PROBATE COURT FOR THE COUNTY OF BARNSTABLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 217 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 29B the following section: —
3 *Section 29C.* The register for Barnstable county may, with
4 the approval of the judges of probate for said county, appoint
5 a clerk who may administer such oaths required in probate
6 proceedings as are not prescribed by law to be administered
7 by the judge or register, and shall perform such clerical and
8 other duties as may be required by the register, with the ap-
9 proval of the judges, and he may be removed by the register
10 with the consent and approval of the judges in the manner
11 provided by section forty-three of chapter thirty-one. Said
12 register may, with the approval of the judges, designate one
13 employee as deputy assistant register and may revoke any
14 such designation at pleasure.
