AN ACT OUTLAWING SALE OR DISTRIBUTION OF COUNTERFEIT SOFT DRINK LABELS TO BE USED TO DISGUISE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTAINERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 24H of Chapter 90, as amended by Chapter 373 of
2 the Acts of 1982, is hereby further amended by adding after
3 the first sentence the following new sentence: —

4 Any person or persons selling or distributing counterfeit
5 soft drink labels designed to be used to disguise cans or con-
6 tainers of alcoholic beverages shall be punished by a fine of
7 not less than one hundred nor more than five hundred dollars,
8 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or both.
