AN ACT PROVIDING PUNISHMENT FOR CERTAIN CRIMES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,  
2 any person who aids or abets the commission of a felony re-  
3 lating to harmful drugs by acting as a lookout, so-called, shall  
4 be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for not less  
5 than five nor more than ten years, or by a fine of no less  
6 than ten thousand dollars, nor more than twenty thousand  
7 dollars, or both such fine and imprisonment.
