AN ACT SEGREGATING FIRST OFFENDERS FROM THE GENERAL PRISON
POPULATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the con-
- 2 trary, any person convicted of a crime and sentenced to state
- 3 prison or a jail or house of correction who has no prior con-
- 4 victions shall be segregated in the state prison or jail or house
- 5 of correction from any prisoner having a prior conviction.
