**AN ACT TO CHANGE THE CLASSIFICATION OF MARIHUANA FROM
CLASS D TO CLASS C.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 31 of chapter 94C of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by striking in paragraph (b) of Class D the
3 following: —

4 (1) Marihuana.

1 SECTION 2. Section 31 of chapter 94C of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by inserting in Class C after the classifi-
3 cation (17) 4-bromo-2, 5-dimethoxy-amphetamine, the follow-
4 ing: —

5 (18) Marihuana.
