RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING UNIFORM ELECTION LAWS AND RELATED MATTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of rep-
3 resentatives, the state secretary or his designee and three
4 persons to be approved by the governor, one of whom shall
5 be a town clerk, one of whom shall be a city clerk, one of
6 whom shall be a county official, is hereby established for the
7 purpose of making an investigation and study relative to
8 establishing uniform election laws including rules and regu-
9 lations. Said commission shall include, but not be limited to,
10 studying the feasibility of establishing uniform voting hours,
11 poll check-in and recount procedures.
