**AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DESIGNATION OF PARTY AFFILIATION
ON ANY BALLOT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary any ballot used
- 2 in a state, county, or municipal election shall have a party
- 3 affiliation printed next to the candidate's name.
