**AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING AND RENEWING OF LICENSES
TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after Section 22A the following section: —
- 3 *Section 22B.* No license for the sale of alcoholic beverages
- 4 under the provisions of sections twelve, fifteen or seventeen
- 5 may be granted or renewed by the licensing authority of a
- 6 city or town to any person, partnership or corporation who
- 7 owes to said city or town outstanding taxes which may or
- 8 not be owed on the premises where such license is located.
