AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF ASSESSMENTS MADE TO
PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 17A of chapter 25 of the General Laws, as amended
2 by section 9 of chapter 514 of the acts of 1978 is hereby fur-
3 ther amended by striking out the second sentence and insert-
4 ing in place thereof the following: —

5 Such assessments shall be collected by the commissioner of
6 revenue in accordance with the applicable provisions of chap-
7 ter sixty-three of the General Laws, provided, however, that
8 each company shall pay an amount equal to one-half the prior
9 fiscal year's assessed amount prior to the first day of Septem-
10 ber of each year. Each company shall pay the remaining bal-
11 ance of the amount assessed against it within thirty days from
12 the receipt of notice of assessment from the commissioner of
13 revenue.
