AN ACT REQUIRING THAT THE GAS FUEL ADJUSTMENT CHARGE BE
ITEMIZED ON ALL BILLS TO CUSTOMERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 119A of chapter 164 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 6 of Chapter 375 of the Acts of
3 1981, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof
4 the following sentence: —

5 All charges for the cost of gas which are imposed by gas
6 companies shall be itemized separately on all bills to cus-
7 tomers.
