AN ACT TO ASSIGN ONE PERCENT (1%) OF THE MASSACHUSETTS STATE LOTTERY FUND TO THE STATE ELDERLY NUTRITION PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 C 1 and Title III C 2 Nutrition Programs are no longer avail-
- 3 able from the Federal Government.
- 4 Increased cost due to inflation and increased demand for
- 5 additional meals makes it necessary to seek new funding re-
- 6 sources in order to maintain an adequate level of service for
- 7 Elderly Nutrition Programs in Massachusetts.
- 8 Be it enacted that one percent (1%) of Massachusetts lot-
- 9 tery be added to the State allotment for elderly meals and that
- 10 the funds be distributed according to formula used for the
- 11 distribution of Title III C 1 and Title III C 2 Federal Funds.
