In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-three.

AN ACT REQUIRING UTILITY COMPANIES TO DISTRIBUTE TO THEIR CUSTOMERS SAVINGS REALIZED AS A RESULT OF PROPOSITION 2½ SO CALLED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 580 of the acts of 1980 is hereby amended by insert-
- 2 ing, after section 12, the following section: —
- 3 *Section 12.* Notwithstanding any general or special law to
- 4 the contrary, any company doing business in the common-
- 5 wealth under the supervision or regulation of the department
- 6 of public utilities shall each year proportionately distribute to
- 7 its customers fifty percent of the amount by which such com-
- 8 pany's real estate taxes for each year is less than the real es-
- 9 tate taxes assessed for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and
- 10 eighty-one.
