In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-three.

AN ACT RELATING TO THE QUALIFICATIONS OF LICENSED  
PRACTICAL NURSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section seventy-four A of chapter one hundred  
2 twelve of the General Laws, as amended, is hereby amended  
3 by striking out the third sentence and inserting in place  
4 thereof, the following sentence: — An applicant who fur-  
5 nishes satisfactory proof that he is of good moral character  
6 and that he is a graduate of a school for practical nurses  
7 approved by the board shall, upon the payment of thirty dol-  
8 lars, be examined by the board and, if found qualified, shall  
9 be licensed practical nurse and to practice as such, and shall  
10 receive a certificate thereof from the board.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
