**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-three.

**AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN HOSPITALS FROM THE CONTROL OF THE  
RATE SETTING COMMISSION.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The provisions of sections thirty-seven to forty-six, inclu-  
2 sive, of chapter six A of the General Laws shall be inopera-  
3 tive for any hospital having one hundred and fifty or fewer  
4 licensed and operating beds on June thirtieth, nineteen hun-  
5 dred and eighty, until June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and  
6 eighty-four; provided, however, that the rate setting commis-  
7 sion established by section thirty-two of said chapter six A  
8 may by regulations require such informational filing from  
9 such hospitals to enable it to assess the cost and charges  
10 for such hospitals until June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and  
11 eighty-four.
