The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-three.

AN ACT INCLUDING THE TOWNS OF TOPSFIELD AND WENHAM IN THE IPSWICH DIVISION OF THE DISTRICT COURT DEPARTMENT OF THE TRIAL COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 218 of the General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the first and third para-  
3 graph under the caption "Essex", and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following two paragraphs: —

5 The Salem division, held at Salem; Salem, Beverly, Dan-  
6 vers, Middleton, Wenham, Manchester, Hamily and Topsfield.

7 The Ipswich division, held at Ipswich; Ipswich, Wenham  
8 and Topsfield.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of July first, nine-  
2 teen hundred and eighty-three.
