AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL COURT OFFICER IN THE THIRD DISTRICT COURT OF PLYMOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

3 the line reading "third district court of Plymouth".
