AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN RECORDS OF THE JUVENILE COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 119 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 60A, as most recently amended by sec-
3 tion 59 of chapter 478 of the acts of 1978, and inserting in
4 place thereof the following section: —
5 *Section 60A.* The records of the court, including those of
6 juvenile appeals session, in all cases of delinquency arising
7 under sections fifty-two to fifty-nine, inclusive, shall be
8 withheld from public inspection except with the consent of a
9 justice of such court, but such records in any such case
10 against any particular child shall be open, at all reasonable
11 times, to the inspection of the child, his or her parent or
12 parents, guardian and attorney, or any of them; provided,
13 however, that such records shall be open to public inspection
14 without such consent if such child is between the ages of
15 fourteen to sixteen, inclusive, and has been previously adjudi-
16 cated delinquent on more than one occasion for acts which
17 would have otherwise constituted felonies if such child had
18 been age seventeen or over.
