AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BERKSHIRE SUPERIOR COURT TO FORFEIT CERTAIN FUNDS AND PAY THEM TO THE TOWN OF GREAT BARRINGTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 This act shall authorize the Berkshire division of the su-
2 perior court department, trial court of Massachusetts, notwith-
3 standing the provisions of section two of chapter two hundred
4 eighty of the General Laws, upon motion of the Berkshire dis-
5 trict attorney, to forfeit any monies which may be due the
6 commonwealth as a result of indictments in said court, num-
7 bered 17074, 17075, and 17076, and dated the twenty-seventh
8 day of October in the year nineteen hundred and eighty-two;
9 said monies to be paid over to the town of Great Barrington
10 to be expended in promoting youth sports and recreational
11 activities.
