### AN ACT RELATING TO SCHOOL BUDGETS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 34 of Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by section 14 of Chapter 782 of the Acts of  
3 1981, is hereby further amended by adding the following  
4 paragraph: —

5 Notwithstanding any general or special law except the  
6 charter provisions of the City of Boston to the contrary, the  
7 annual budget as submitted by the mayor shall include a  
8 recommendation for the support of schools in the amount re-  
9 quested by the school committee, provided that the mayor  
10 shall not be precluded from advising the city council on the  
11 amount of appropriation for the support of the schools which  
12 he deems to be appropriate. Such advice shall not be binding  
13 on the city council.
