AN ACT RELATIVE TO COMPENSATION PAID THE BOARD OF ASSESSORS  
IN THE TOWN OF BECKET.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section one hundred eight  
2 of Chapter forty-one of the General Laws or any other provi-  
3 sion of laws to the contrary, the action of the Town of Becket,  
4 taken on August 18, 1981 at a special town meeting, rescind-  
5 ing the vote taken at the annual town meeting which fixed the  
6 salaries of the members of the Board of Assessors and the ac-  
7 tion taken at the special town meeting which fixed the salaries  
8 of each member of the Board of Assessors at \$12,634.65, both  
9 to be retroactive to the beginning of Fiscal Year 1982, and  
10 which raised and appropriated the sum of \$31,153.95 for the  
11 payment of the increases in said salaries, is hereby confirmed  
12 and validated.

This is to certify that at the Annual Town Meeting held on May 15, 1982 at the Becket School the following article was moved, seconded and passed.

Article 13. To see if the Town will vote to approve the filing of a petition in the General Court seeking to validate the action of the Town of Becket taken at a special town meeting increasing the salary fixed for the FY 1982 for certain elected officials of the Town, to read substantially as follows: —

*Section 1.* Notwithstanding the provisions of section one hundred eight of Chapter forty-one of the General Laws or any other provision of laws to the contrary, the action of the Town of Becket, taken on August 18, 1981 at a special town meeting, rescinding the vote taken at the annual town meeting which fixed the salaries of the members of the Board of Assessors and the action taken at the special town meeting which fixed the salaries of each member of the Board of Assessors at \$12,634.65, both to be retroactive to the beginning of Fiscal Year 1982, and which raised and appropriated the sum of \$31,153.95 for the payment of the increases in said salaries, is hereby confirmed and validated.

*Section 2.* This act shall take effect upon its passage.
