AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF HERBICIDES BY PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 6B of Chapter 132B as most recently amended is
- 2 further amended by adding the following new paragraph: —
- 3 A utility company, or an applicator acting at the direction
- 4 of a utility company, which complies with the notification pro-
- 5 visions of this section and which complies with all other appli-
- 6 cable provisions of this act is authorized to use herbicides ac-
- 7 cording to the provisions of this section, subject only to any
- 8 such determinations by the department pursuant to Section 12
- 9 of this act.
