AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND CERTAIN REGISTRY OFFICIALS TO ISSUE HANDICAPPED REGISTRATION PLATES FROM REGISTRY OFFICES OUTSIDE OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The registrar is hereby authorized and directed, through his  
2 employees in charge of the individual registry of motor vehicle  
3 offices outside of Boston, to issue handicapped registration  
4 plates to those persons qualifying as a handicapped or dis-  
5 abled person in accordance with written requirements to be is-  
6 sued forthwith by the registrar to said registry offices.
