AN ACT RELATIVE TO MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE AND REGISTRATION FEES FOR INDIVIDUALS AGE SIXTY-FIVE OR OLDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The tenth paragraph of subsection 7 of section
- $2\ 33$  of chapter 90 is hereby amended by adding the following
- 3 sentence: For every license of an individual age sixty-five
- 4 or older to operate motor vehicles or the renewal thereof, the
- 5 fee shall not be more than ten dollars.
- 1 Section 2. Said section 33 of said chapter 90 is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following: For the registration of
- 3 a motor vehicle by an individual age sixty-five or older, the
- 4 fee shall not be more than seven dollars; and for the issuance
- 5 in connection with the registration of any motor vehicle, at
- 6 the request of the applicant of a distinctive initial plate, ten
- 7 dollars; or of a particular number plate other than a distinc-
- 8 tive initial plate, two dollars.
