AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING A MOTOR VEHICLE USED FOR THE  
TRANSPORTATION OF SCHOOL CHILDREN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 7D of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by chapter 552 of the Acts of 1976, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the first sentence and insert-  
4 ing in place thereof the following sentence: —

5 The requirements of clauses (1), (2), (3), (5), (7), (8),  
6 (9), (10), (13), and (16) of section seven B shall apply to  
7 any motor vehicle, having permanent seating accommodations  
8 for and carrying not more than the seating capacity desig-  
9 nated by the manufacturer, that is regularly used for the  
10 transportation of school pupils, while so used.
