

By Ms. Buckley, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1375) of Anna P. Buckley for legislation to place certain employees in Group 2 of the contributory retirement law. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-three.

AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN EMPLOYEES IN GROUP 2 OF THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32
 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the
 3 definition of Group 2, as most recently amended by section
 4 88 and section 134 of chapter 329 of the acts of 1980, and in-
 5 serting in place thereof the following definition: —
 6 *Group 2.* Public works building police, permanent water-
 7 shed guards and permanent park police; University of Massa-
 8 chusetts police; all court officers having police powers; and
 9 employees of the Sergeant-at-arms department of the General
 10 Court; employees of the Massachusetts Port Authority, com-
 11 prising guards, guard sergeants, head guard and chief of
 12 waterfront police; officials and employees of the department
 13 of public safety having police powers; employees of a muni-
 14 cipal department who are employed as fire or police signal
 15 operators or signal maintenance repairmen; ambulance at-
 16 tendants of a municipal department who are required to re-
 17 spond to fires and perform duties assigned to them; employ-
 18 ees of a city or town who are employed as licensed electricians
 19 and elevator maintenance men employed by a county; employ-
 20 ees of Cushing Hospital; employees of the commonwealth or
 21 of any county, regardless of any official classification, except
 22 the sheriff, superintendent, deputy superintendant, assistant
 23 deputy superintendent, and correction officers of any county
 24 correctional facilities whose regular and major duties require
 25 them to have care, custody, instruction, or other supervision

26 of prisoners; and employees of the commonwealth or of any
27 county whose regular and major duties require them to have
28 the care and custody, instruction or other supervision of
29 parolees or persons who are mentally ill or mentally defec-
30 tive delinquents or wayward children; provided, that no mem-
31 ber who attains age sixty-five while classified in Group 1 may
32 thereafter be classified in Group 2, irrespective of change of
33 employment.
