AN ACT TO GRANT FOR SERVICE IN THE ARMED FORCES TOWARD STATE RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 All certified veterans of World War One, World War Two,
2 Korean Conflict, and the Viet Nam War shall be given credit
3 toward retirement and vacation benefits equal to service time,
4 but at no time be given more than four years total time for
5 all wars if they work for the city, town, county, or state gov-
6 ernment in the commonwealth as of July 1983, provided that
7 such time or service is more than five years with the town,
8 city, county, or the commonwealth prior to July 1, 1983. The
9 word 'certified veteran' will apply only to those veterans who
10 served during a declared emergency for all wars and be regu-
11 lated by benefits paid for all veterans by the Federal govern-
12 ment and further that all veterans be assessed due monies for
13 their credited service time set by the legislature in their ses-
14 sion 1982-1983.
